For the referral program, a new student is defined as a family who has never attended CES in the past. This referral bonus is also available to CES staff members.

The CES application for enrollment of new students will include a section for referring families or staff to be named.

CES staff members will be paid through regular payroll. Families paying annually have the option to receive a check or an account credit. Families paying monthly will receive an account credit.
