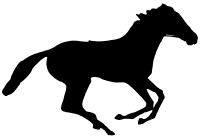
# Pre-K4 Class Quilt

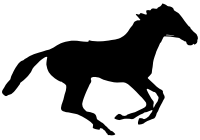
# 1st Grade Class Quilt

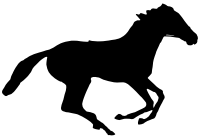
## 6th Grade Class Quilt

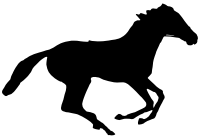

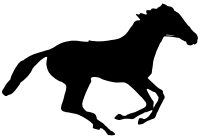

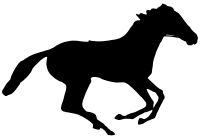
# 8th Grade Class Quilt

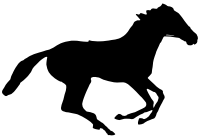
