

Grading Periods

### **ARRIVAL AND DISMISSAL**

\*For all walkups, guardians are to park in the library parking lot during dropoff and dismissal times.\*

### **Drop-off/Arrival**

All students 7:45 - 8:00 AM - Main Campus 603 Spring Street

- CES staff will be waiting in front of the church to oversee students as they are unloading from their vehicles and will be led to their classrooms.
- Students may be walked to their school building between 7:45-8 AM.
- If arriving after 8:00 AM, parents must lead their child into school or church.
- School begins promptly at 8:00 AM.

### **Dismissal**

<u>Half-day Pre-K3 and Pre-K4 students 1:00 – 1:10 PM - Main Campus</u>

- Walkup pickup CES staff will be waiting in the courtyard with your child.
- Car rider pickup CES staff will be waiting in front of the church to safely assist children as they load into their vehicles.
  - Calvary staff are not permitted to buckle children into car seats. If your child is not able to buckle on their own, please park at the library and pick up your child in the courtyard as a walkup.
- Dismissal promptly ends at 1:10 PM.

Full-day students PreK through 8th grade 3:00-3:10 PM - Main Campus

- CES staff will call your child's name for dismissal.
- Walkup pickup CES staff will be waiting in the courtyard with your child.
- Car rider pickup CES staff will be waiting in front of the church to safely assist children as they load into their vehicles.
  - Calvary staff are not permitted to buckle children into car seats. If your child is not able to buckle on their own, please park at the library and pick up your child in the courtyard as a walkup.
- Dismissal promptly ends at 3:10 PM.

### <u> Aftercare 3:10 – 6:00 PM</u>

- Children must be registered.
- Aftercare promptly ends at 6:00 PM late charges will apply thereafter.

# **CAR RIDER LINE FLOW ROUTE**

Follow the traffic pattern depicted below and move to the first available space. Wait for your child to either unload from or load into your vehicle and then safely and promptly exit the car rider line so the next vehicle can pull up.

- Drivers should not be on cell phones while in the car rider line.
- Please do not exit your vehicle no unattended vehicles.
