Grading Periods

Arrival and Dismissal

Arrival - All students 7:45 - 8:00 AM

- CES staff will be waiting in front of the church to oversee students as they
 are unloading from their vehicles and will be led to their classrooms.
- After 8:00 AM, parents must lead their child into school or church.
- The safest place to park that is permitted is the library parking lot.
- School begins promptly at 8:00 AM.

Dismissal

Half-day Pre-K3 and Pre-K4 students 1:00 - 1:10 PM

- Walkup pickup CES staff will be waiting in the courtyard with your child.
- Car rider pickup CES staff will be waiting in front of the church to safely assist children as they load into their vehicles.
 - Calvary staff is not permitted to buckle children into car seats. If your child is not able to buckle on their own, please park at the library and pick up your child in the courtyard as a walkup.
- Dismissal promptly ends at 1:10 PM.

Full-day students PreK through 8th grade 3:00-3:10 PM

- CES staff will call your child's name for dismissal.
- Walkup pickup CES staff will be waiting in the courtyard with your child.
- Car rider pickup CES staff will be waiting in front of the church to safely assist children as they load into their vehicles.
 - Calvary staff is not permitted to buckle children into car seats. If your child is not able to buckle on their own, please park at the library and pick up your child in the courtyard as a walkup.
- Dismissal promptly ends at 3:10 PM.

Aftercare 3:10 - 6:00 PM

- Children must be registered.
- Aftercare promptly ends at 6:00 PM.

Car Rider Line Flow Route

Follow the traffic pattern depicted below and move to the first available space. Wait for your child to either unload from or load into your vehicle and then safely and promptly exit the car rider line so the next vehicle can pull up.

- Drivers should not be on cell phones while in car rider line.
- Please do not exit your vehicle no unattended vehicles.
